### <u>Timeline</u>

#### 1. School Team Selection

Each school can register up to 3 teams to participate and compete. (Each team comprising of 4 students)

Each team must develop the following:

- <u>Business Plan Overview (30 points)</u>: a brief two (2) page <u>abstract</u> that addresses the business concept, the product, how the business will be setup and managed, and who would be your potential customers.
- <u>Marketing Research and Projected Sales (20 points)</u>: a brief one page that describes the research you performed that proves your concept will work successfully and an outline of projected sales you will make with your business.

<u>Infomercial (20 points)</u>: a brief 30 - 60 second marketing video commercial that sells your product. If you have a logo designed for your product or service, please ensure to use it in your video. (Submit online at www.eduserc.org/convention-serctank)

<u>A Working Prototype (30 points)</u> (or simulated example that your concept works, if you are promoting a service)

### Marketing Research and Projected Sales (20 points) (1 page)

1. <u>Marketing Research & Risk Assessment:</u> Clearly explain why you strongly believe your business idea will work and be a major success? Make sure to include any research data or other information that can convince an investor that your idea is a low risk, but high value for a return on their investment.


<u>Projected Sales:</u> Outline your projected sales you anticipate from your business. List your gross income, expenses and projected net sales. Provide detail to help explain how the numbers are generated to determine you sales. NOTE: Gross Income – Expenses = Projected Net Sales)
